Bryan Tews (2B & RHP) of Brown University was selected to the 2006 All-Ivy Baseball Team announced on May 9. He was selected on the first team as a second basemen and on the second team as a pitcher. Bryan was the leading hitter in the Ivy League with an overall average of .390 in 36 games, including a .380 average in Ivy League contests. In those 20 league games, he had 30 hits, 17 RBI and 20 runs scored. He ranked # 2 in the league with a 1.85 ERA. As the leagues most versatile player, he pitched, batted and fielded. Bryan started nine games on the mound and 26 games as an infielder making only 10 errors in 157 chances.
