Shane Davis LHP Canisius College

Shane is 2-0 on the young season with a 4.82 ERA. In his most recent outing vs. Appalachian State he threw 5 1/3 innings scoreless innings, allowing six hits with four walks and four strikeouts. In start # 1 vs. Long Island, he pitched four innings and gave up five runs on four hits but qualified as the winning pitcher.

Blake Nation RHP Georgia Southern University

Blake has pitched in relief in three contests so far. He has not allowed a run, has given up nine hits in eight innings, walked three and struck out 10 hitters. He got his first save in his most recent outing vs. Towson University. In his first stint vs. Boston College, he threw 2 1/3 innings, gave up two hits and struck out three. Against Georgia Tech, he pitched middle relief and gave up two hits in 2 2/3 innings and struck out five Tech hitters.

Chad Stang Outfielder Midland College

The freshman outfielder from British Columbia has gotten off to a good start to his collegiate career. In 16 games of Texas JC Baseball, he is hitting at a .367 clip with 19 runs, 22 hits, six doubles, one triple and a home run while driving in 18 runs in 16 games. In the conference opening doubleheader, Chad was 5 for-8 with four runs scored, two RBI, two doubles and a triple.

Evan McDole First Base University of Northern Kentucky

The sophomore first sacker is presently hitting .375 in five games with one double and an RBI while batting # 4 in the NKU lineup. Against # 3 ranked University of Tampa he was 4 for-10 (.400) on the weekend series.

Ryan Schmidt LHP University of Northern Kentucky

Pitched a great game vs. Tampa in the final game of a three game series. He threw seven scoreless innings, then gave up two runs in the eighth inning and his bullpen cost him a hard fought win, giving up a 4-2 lead in the eighth inning. In his initial game of the season, he pitched three innings, gave up two hits and no runs. His stats presently show a 0-0 record with a 2.70 ERA.

Jonathan Kosco Infielder University of South Florida

Starting at second base as a freshman. Through eight games, he is hitting .310 with two doubles and two RBI. He had two consecutive 2-for-4 games vs. Florida Gulf Coast and Bethune-Cookman. He has made one error in 32 chances in the field.

Anthony Giansanti Outfielder Siena College

Has played in all five games so far and is batting .364 with a double, home run and RBI. He hit his home run vs. Florida in Gainesville in a 10-7 loss to the Gators.

Luis Feliz Outfielder Rutgers University

In the first five games of the 2008 spring season, Luis is batting .231 with two doubles and two RBI. He went 2-for-4 with a double in a big win over Georgia Tech and had a two run double vs. Old Dominion.

Tyler Lee LHP University of the Cumberland

Tyler has a 3-1 record with a 3.13 ERA. In 22 innings, he has given up 18 hits with 19 strikeouts. Batters are hitting .231 against his offerings.

Ethan Wilson Infielder University of Indiana

After a year and a half of injury rehab, Ethan had his initial start as a Hoosier and went 2-for-4 with two runs, a home run and three RBI. He is presently hitting .333.

Adam Veres RHP St. Petersburg College

Adam has pitched in eight games, seven as a starter and has a 1-1 record. In 33+ innings he has walked nine and struck out 33 hitters. In a start vs. Lake City CC he threw six innings, gave up three runs, walked one and struck out ten. Against defending national champion Chipola Junior College in his last start, he allowed only three hits, two runs and struck out six hitters.

Matt Quevedo RHP University of South Florida

The # 2 starter for USF has started two games, against Indiana State and Northwestern. Against Indiana State, he threw 4 2/3 innings, allowing three hits, two runs and struck out six. In his start vs. Northwestern, he allowed only two runs until a disastrous 6th inning when he allowed five runs.

Juan (Junior) Carlin LHP University of South Florida

Has made three appearances in relief, including an inning vs. the New York Yankees in an exhibition game at Legends Field. Against Oklahoma State, he threw one and 1/3

innings and gave up no hits, walked two and struck out one. Junior pitched one inning vs. the Yankees and gave up no hits and walked one

Jarrett Lukas Infielder University of Maine

Batting .462 in five games. He had a great series vs. Delaware State in the opening series. In a doubleheader sweep, Jarrett went 3-for-9 with three runs, six RBI, two doubles and a home run. He was selected as the America East Conference Rookie of the Week for February 25-March 2. Against Florida International, Jarrett went 3-for-4 with an RBI (#7).

Nick McCoy Catcher University of San Diego.

In a start vs. Fresno State he went 1-for-3 with an RBI. In another game. vs. San Diego State, he was 0-for-2

Michael Earley Infielder University of Indiana

Highly touted transfer from Cincinnati has struggled coming out of the gate. He had a 2-for-4 performance with one run and two RBI vs. Illinois State

Jamie Storey LHP Midland College

He has started the season with victories over Weatherford College and Ranger College in Texas Junior College play. He has thrown 14 innings and has walked eight and struck out 15 opposing hitters.
